How We Keep the Place Running:

Membership fees are used for supplies and tool replacement and maintenance.

When possible we will do repairs on wood products brought to the shop by residents of OTOW. Donations from those projects are used to purchase material for toy making and for the purchase and maintenance of shop equipment.

Shop repairs and improvements are carried out by members on a volunteer basis. We encourage anyone with a little spare time to stop by the Toy Shop and help out for a couple of hours or even a few minutes.

The Toy Shop

The Toy Shop is the place where the Fixers, Fiddlers and Fumblers had their beginnings and it is the engine that powers the club to this very day. The time, energy and creativity of this tiny army of volunteers feeds the machine that so many fixers enjoy for our own benefit.

The Toy Shop super elves design and build cars, trucks, cradles, and wagons that are, in turn, painted by the crew of the Caring and Sharing Project, located just across the way in the East Activity Center. From there, the toys are passed on to thousands of kids who face a variety of disadvantages. Just where the toys go specifically is a mystery, for obvious security reasons. It's enough for these guys that they go to kids.

The Toy Shop volunteers are more than that. They pay the same dues as those of us who use the facilities of the Fixers, Fiddlers and Fumblers for our own pleasure and benefit.
